0144.1 Board Member Development in Service

State, Regional and National workshops, conventions, conferences and seminars developed by associations such as the New Jersey School Boards Association, the National School Boards Association, and the New Jersey Association of School Administrators provide unique opportunities for Board members to broaden their understanding for their responsibilities, learn new tools and techniques for coping with them and keep up to date on educational trends.

Therefore, in addition to sending the required delegate to the New Jersey School Boards Association Delegate Assemblies, the Board endorses sending Board and Administration representatives to other educational conferences, workshops, conventions and seminars within the funds available and authorized by the Board each year.

The Board of Education will arrange to make direct payment for up to three (3) nights lodging for in-State attendance for each Board member, the Superintendent and Board Secretary.

No more than three representatives may be sent to a particular out-of-state event, which representation may include the Superintendent, if deemed advisable by the Board. For out-of-state attendance the Board will arrange to make direct payment for up to four (4) nights lodging and air fare for each of the three district representatives.

Payment for expenses at approved educational conferences workshops, conventions, and seminars may be made on a per diem basis or upon presentation of an itemized statement of expenses for food and other related expenses for the entire period of attendance as previously authorized by the Board.
